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### 2001, No. 5

An Act of the Parliament of the Cook Islands to appropriate certain sums of money out of the Cook Islands Government Account to the services of the year ending with the thirtieth day of June 2001 and to appropriate the supplies granted in this period

(17 April 2001)

**MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:** We, your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Parliament of the Cook Islands, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this year, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sum hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted. And be it enacted by the Parliament of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title – This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Amendment Act 2001 which shall be read together with and deemed part of the Appropriation Act 2000 (“the principal Act”).

2. Grant and appropriation out of the Cook Islands Government Account - Subsection (1) of Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by deleting the amount of \$70,225,352 and substituting the amount of \$75,443,820.

3. Schedules – The principal Act is further amended by deleting the Schedules and substituting the following Schedules:

- (a) Schedule 1 – Ministry Appropriations;
- (b) Schedule 1(b) – Outer Island Appropriations;
- (c) Schedule 2 – Benefits and Other Unrequited Expenses;
- (d) Schedule 3 – Borrowing Expenses and Debt Repayments;
- (e) Schedule 4 – Other Expenses.

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This Act is administered by the Ministry of Finance and Economic Management
