An Act to amend the Civil List Act 1968

(3 April 1969)

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This Act may be cited as the Civil List Amendment Act 1968-69 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil List Act 1968 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").
(2) Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of August 1968.
(3) Section 4 of this Act shall come into force on the date of assent.

2. Salary of Members - Section 13 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "to whom the foregoing provisions of this Act do not apply".

3. New section inserted - The principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting after section 17 the following new section:-

"17A. Expenses of members travelling to meetings - There may be paid out of the Cook Islands Government Account such sums as may be required to meet return passage moneys or fares of members travelling to attend a meeting of the Legislative Assembly or any Committee thereof".

4. Appropriation of moneys for benefits and privileges - Section 21 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in subsection (1) thereof, after the word "Ministers", and before the words "or members", the words "the Speaker".
