An Act to amend the Constitution

(25 March 1969)

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands  
in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the Constitution  
Amendment Act 1968-69, and shall be read together with and  
deemed part of the Constitution of the Cook Islands as set out  
in the second schedule to the Cook Islands Constitution  
Amendment Act 1965 of the Parliament of New Zealand (hereinafter  
referred to as "the Constitution").

2. Prorogation and dissolution of Legislative Assembly - The  
Constitution is hereby amended by omitting the word "three" in  
subclause (4) of Article 37, and substituting the word "four".
