An Act to amend the provisions of the Constitution
relating to designation of special posts
(20 January 1971)

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the Constitution Amendment (No. 4) Act 1970 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Constitution of the Cook Islands as set out in the Second Schedule to the Cook Islands Constitution Amendment Act 1965 (hereinafter referred to as "the Constitution").

2. Functions of Public Service Commission - Subclause (3) of Article 74B of the Constitution is hereby amended by omitting the words "or any other senior post in the Cook Islands Public Service;" and substituting the words "in the Cook Islands Public Service, and not more than one senior post in the Cook Islands Public Service in each of the islands of the Cook Islands other than Rarotonga;".

This Act is administered in the Public Service Commission.

the number of Cabinet Ministers by one

(20 January 1971

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook
Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the
Constitution Amendment (No. 5) Act 1970 and shall be
read together with and deemed part of the Constitution
of the Cook Islands as set out in the Second Schedule
to the Cook Islands Constitution Amendment Act 1965
(hereinafter referred to as "the Constitution").
2. Cabinet - Subclause (1) of Article 13 of the
Constitution is hereby amended by omitting the word
"five" and substituting the word "six".

This Act is administered in the Premier's Department.
