An Act to amend the Education Act 1966

(29 February 1968)

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act 1968 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act").

2. Compulsory Attendance - Section 31 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection:-

"(1) Subject to the provisions of sections 33 and 34 of this Act, every child from the time of his sixth birthday to the end of the school year during which he attains the age of fifteen years, shall be enrolled at, and shall attend a school:

Provided that the Director may, at his discretion, exempt any child who has attained the age of fifteen years from enrolment and attendance at school."

3. Child not to be in public place at certain times - The principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting, after section 35, the following section:-
