EXEMPTION FROM REQUIREMENTS IN COOK ISLANDS CIVIL AVIATION RULE (CICAR) 19.357 AND 139.119 EXE-2020-003

PURSUANT TO Section 40 of the Civil Aviation Act 2002,

I, **Dennis Vivian John Hoskin**, Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that:

- a) The petition submitted by Airport Authority Cook Islands to exempt from the requirements to CICAR 139.357 for airport identity cards and CICAR 139.119 access to airside for vehicles at Rarotonga International Airport;
- b) That sufficient mitigations are in place to manage the risk to safety and security at Rarotonga International Airport.

HEREBY EXEMPT Airport Authority Cook Islands, being a holder of Aviation Certificates issued under CICAR Parts 139 and 140, from the requirements of CICAR 19.357 for airport identity cards and CICAR 139.119 for access to airside with respect to a memorial service for the late Mr. Barry Hill, to be held at the Rarotonga Rescue Fire Station, Rarotonga International Airport on 19th August 2020.

PROVIDED THAT Airport Authority Cook Islands ensure sufficient aviation, security and operational personnel are on duty to supervise the attendees and vehicles and ensure the operational safety and security of the Rarotonga Airport is not compromised.

This exemption shall be in force from 1200 hours to 1700 hours on 19th August 2020.
