COOK ISLANDS
PARLIAMENTARY GENERAL ELECTION 2018

PURSUANT to Sections 30(2), 31(1) and 111(b) of the Electoral Act 2004 (the Act), I, TAGGY TANGIMETUA, Chief Electoral Officer, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE the following dates and times for the Parliamentary General Election:

1. **Thursday 14 June 2018** is the day appointed by the Queen's Representative on which the election of Members of the Cook Islands Parliament shall be held.
2. Nominations of candidates shall close on **Monday 30 April 2018 at 12 noon** and each and every such nomination together with the sum of **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)** shall be lodged at the office of the Chief Electoral at the Ministry of Finance (MFEM) or at the Ministry of Justice Avarua Rarotonga. In the case of those in "Te Pa Enuā" all nominations and fees shall be lodged with the office of the Deputy Registrar of the High Court.
3. The Main Roll shall close on **Thursday 19 April 2018 at 4.00pm**.
4. The Supplementary Roll shall close on **Thursday 3 May 2018 at 4.00pm**.
5. Objections to names on the Main Roll shall close on **Thursday 26 April 2018 at 4.00pm**.
6. Objections to names on the Supplementary Roll shall close on **Thursday 10 May 2018 at 4.00pm**.

PARLIAMENT OF THE COOK ISLANDS


KIA ORANA to the PEOPLE of the COOK ISLANDS.

WHEREAS the Parliament of the Cook Islands, was adjourned sine die; and given this is the year for a 'General Election', and in order to accord the incoming Government the opportunity to address the issue of a new Appropriation for the new fiscal year, I have accepted the Prime Minister's advice to call for a fresh election.

Therefore; in pursuance of Article 37 (3) of the Constitution of the Cook Islands, **I, TOM MARSTERS,** Queen's Representative of the Cook Islands, do hereby dissolve Parliament forthwith and appoint Thursday 14th June, 2018 as the appointed date for the next General Election.
