2011, No. 4An Act to amend the Public Holidays Act 2009**(14 July 2011)**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short title and commencement – (1) This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays (Ra o te Ui Ariki) Amendment Act 2011 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Holidays Act 2009 (herein after referred to as “the principal Act”).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st of January 2012.

2. Interpretation - Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of “Easter Monday” the following:

“Ra o te Ui Ariki” shall mean the 6th day of July in each year.

3. Island Gospel Days - Section 4 of the principal Act is repealed.

4. Savings - Section 5 of the principal Act is repealed.

5. Schedules - (1) The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended by adding the following -

“Ra o te Ui Ariki”

(2) The Second Schedule to the principal Act is repealed.
