An Act to amend the Wandering Stock Ordinance, 1951

(1 October 1968)

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands
in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the
Wandering Stock Amendment Act 1968 and shall be read
together with and deemed part of the Wandering Stock
Ordinance 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance").

2. Animal trespass - The Ordinance is hereby amended
by inserting after section 5 the following new section:

"5A. Animal trespass - (1) Every person commits
an offence and is liable to a fine not
exceeding fifty dollars who permits or
causes any animal to wander or be at
large in any public place or to trespass
upon any land.

(2) For the purposes of this section
"public place" means any road, any place
of public resort open to or used by the
public as of right, any wharf or jetty,
any church or other building where Divine
service is being publicly held, any hall
or room in which any public entertainment
is being held, and any market place."

3. Repeal - Section 252 of the Cook Islands Act 1915
is hereby repealed.
