Pursuant to section 34 of the COVID-19 Act 2020, His Excellency the Queen's Representative, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations—

#### Regulations

- 1 Title**  
 These regulations are the COVID-19 (Border Entry Requirements) Amendment Regulations 2022.
- 2 Commencement**  
 These regulations come into force on **25 July 2022**.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**  
 These regulations amend the COVID-19 (Border Entry Requirements) Regulations 2022 (the **principal regulations**).

**4 Regulation 7 replaced (Entry requirements to enter Cook Islands by aircraft)**

Replace regulation 7 of the principal regulations with:

**“7 Entry requirements to enter Cook Islands by aircraft**

- “(1) A person may enter the Cook Islands by aircraft only if the person is vaccinated and provides evidence of vaccination (unless, under regulation 16, the person is not required to comply with vaccination requirements).
- “(2) This regulation is subject to Part 3 (exemptions and waivers).”
