REGULATIONS

- Title and commencement – (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Chattels Transfer (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2005.
(2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 2005.
- Fees – There shall be paid to the Registrar for the various matters set out in the Schedule hereto the respective fees set out in that Schedule.
- Value Added Tax – The fees specified in these Regulations are inclusive of value added tax under the Value Added Tax Act 1997.
- Revocation – The Chattels Transfer (Fees) Regulations 1995 No. 9 is hereby revoked.
