ORDER

1. Title and commencement - This Order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1988.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of December 1987.

2. Allowances of the Queen's Representative - (1) There shall be paid to the Queen's Representative the following allowances in every year :-

- (a) An expense allowance of \$16,500; and
- (b) A clothing allowance of \$2,500.

(2) The allowances set out in subsection (1) shall from time to time be increased in accordance with any general cost of living increase to salaries from time to time granted to members of the Public Service.

3. Repeal - The Civil List Order 1984 Serial No.06 is hereby repealed.
