1. Short Title - This Order may be cited as the Commission of Inquiry (Italian Hotel Project) Order 1989.

2. Commission constituted - There shall be established a Commission of Inquiry to be known as the Italian Hotel Project Commission of Inquiry, to comprise the following persons -

- (a) George Frederick Ellis, who shall be Chairman;
- (b) John Meredith Scott
- (c) Timothy Paul Arnold

3. Terms of reference - The terms of reference of the Commission shall be to inquire into and report upon the

proposed construction of a hotel on the island of Rarotonga,
and shall in particular-

- (a) Examine all documents, correspondence, contracts and plans relating to the said proposed project;
- (b) Identify what commitments have been entered into by Government;
- (c) Recommend alternative courses of action available to Government;
- (d) Advise on the likely financial, legal and other implications that any alternative courses of action might present.
