1. Title - This Order may be cited as the Commission of Inquiry (Patrol Boat "Te Kukupa") Order 1990.

2. Commission constituted - There shall be established a Commission of Inquiry to be known as the Patrol Boat "Te Kukupa" Commission of Inquiry, to comprise the following persons:

- (c) Mathilda Miria-Tairea

3. Terms of Reference - The terms of reference of the Commission shall be to inquire into and report upon the operations of the Patrol Boat "Te Kukupa" in particular -
