“Category S007 Members” means all employees of the Aitutaki Power Supply who are not members of the New Zealand Government Superannuation Fund and their employer.

3. Application of Act to Category S007 Members – The Cook Islands National Superannuation Fund Act 2000 shall apply to Category S007 Members.
