### RULES

1. Title and Commencement - (1) These Rules may be cited as the Court of Appeal Rules Amendment 2005 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Court of Appeal Rules 1981 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules").

(2) These Rules shall come into force on the 1st day of August 2005.

2. New scale of fees substituted - The principal Rules are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule thereto, and substituting it with the Schedule as set out in these Rules.

- 10B For the transmission of documents at the request of a party, by the use of a courier shall be the actual cost plus 10% to cover processing and handling expenses
- 10C For any teleconference made at the request of a party, the cost shall be the actual cost plus 10% to cover preparation.
11. Copy of judgment or order (other than copy supplied to a party to the proceedings)-
- (a) Not exceeding 5 pages \$10
  - (b) Exceeding 5 pages \$20
  - (c) Exceeding 20 pages \$30
12. Copy of any document other than judgment or order (other than copy supplied to a party to the proceedings)
- a) First page \$3
  - b) In excess of 1 page but less than 10 pages \$2/p
  - c) In excess of 10 pages \$1/p
13. For certifying a copy of judgment or order or any other Court document any document
- a) Not exceeding 5 pages \$10
  - b) Exceeding 5 pages \$20
  - c) Exceeding 20 pages \$30
14. Search of Court records (including register and files relating to a particular proceeding) – for each search \$5
15. Checking any draft order \$10
