REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement - (1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Amendment Regulations 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1959 (N.Z.S.R. 1959/93) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").
(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 23 November 1989
2. Overtime - (1) Regulation 13 (1) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the expression "\$9.32" and substituting with the expression "\$9.60"
(2) Regulation 13 (1) of the principal regulation is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the expression "\$6.96" and substituting with the expression "\$7.17"
3. Fees for Officers' time - Regulation 14 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$4.65" and substituting with the expression "\$4.79"
