ORDER

1. Title and commencement - (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs (Duty Exemption) Order 1987.
(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of May 1987.

2. Duty exemption - All goods imported into the Cook Islands from Australia and produced or manufactured in Australia shall be admitted into the Cook Islands free of duty.
