REGULATIONS

1. Title - These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Overtime) Amendment Regulations 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1959 (N.Z.S.R. 1959/93) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

2. Overtime - (1) Regulation 13(1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the expression "\$9.60" and substituting it with the expression "\$10.08".

(2) Regulation 13(1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the expression "\$7.17" and substituting it with the expression "\$7.53".

3. Fees for officers' time - Regulation 14(1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$4.70" and substituting it with the expression "\$5.03".
