	1. Where the duty (excluding import levy assessable under Part I of the Tariff and vehicles admissible under reference number 56 does not exceed \$5,000.00 the import levy payable on such vehicles shall not exceed the difference between \$5,000.00 and the amount of duty payable.	
	2. Where the duty (excluding import levy) assessable under Part I of the Tariff on vehicles admissible under reference number 56 exceeds \$5,000.00 the import levy payable shall be the full amount assessable under Part I.	
58.	Casks or drums, empty on importation of sheet or plate iron or steel and with a carrying capacity of 180 litre or more, of a kind commonly used for the carriage of petroleum products.	Free"
