PURSUANT to Sections 7 and 9 of the Customs Tariff Act 1989, His Excellency the Queen's Representative, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following Order.

**ORDER**

1. Title - This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment (Vegetable Products) Order 2000, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1989 ("the principal Order").

2. Edible vegetables and nuts - (1) Subject to subclause (2), the rates of levy payable pursuant to the Customs Tariff Act 1980 for the items described in the First Schedule under the respective tariff classification numbers shall be as set out in that Schedule.

**Price \$1.50**

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1), the rates of levy set out in the First Schedule shall apply from the months of December to August (inclusive) in each year but otherwise the rates of levy imposed immediately before this Order came into force shall apply as if this Order had not been promulgated.

3. Coffee, juices, desiccated coconut and coconut cream (1) Subject to subclauses (2) and (3) the rates of levy payable pursuant to the Customs Tariff Act 1980 for the items described in the Second Schedule under the respective tariff classification numbers shall be as set out in that Schedule.

(2) The rate of levy prescribed for coconut cream under tariff description number 21061000 in the Second Schedule shall apply to imports originating from Samoa only.

(3) The rate of levy for coconut cream under tariff description 21061000 imported into the Cook Islands other than from Samoa shall be as prescribed by the Customs Tariff Amendment (Coconut Cream) Order 1997.
