#### ORDER

- 1. Short Title This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Fuel) Amendment Order 1988 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Order").
- 2. Motor spirits and distillate fuels (1) Chapter 27 Part I of the principal Order is amended by deleting the words set out in the First Schedule to this Order and substituting the words set out in the Second Schedule.
- (2) Part II of the principal Order is amended by deleting the words set out in the Third Schedule and substituting the words set out in the Fourth Schedule.
