ORDER

1. Title – This Order may be cited as the Entry, Residence and Departure (Exemption) Order 2008.

2. Exercise of special power of Minister – (1) The Minister hereby exempts from the provisions of Part III and IV of the Act persons who are married to a Cook Islander or Permanent Resident and have been in such marriage for a period of not less than five years at the date of the coming into force of this Order.

(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of section 2 shall prevent any person so exempted from making an application for Permanent Residence under section 5 of the Act.
