- 1 **Title**
These regulations are the Entry, Residence and Departure Regulations 2012.
- 2 **Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 1 January 2013.
- 3 **Schedule**
The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by deleting Form No.10 and substituting the new form contained in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 4 **Repeal**
The Entry, Residence and Departure Amendment Regulations 1998 is repealed.
