ORDER

1. Title and commencement - This Order may be cited as the Films and Censorship (Fees) Order 1987 and shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1988.

2. Licence fees - The fees payable annually to the Censor for the issue of a renter's licence and for an exhibitor's licence shall be as set out in the schedule to this Order.

3. Examination fees - The fees payable to the censor for the examination by the censor of video tapes, cinematographic film, documents and sound tapes shall be as set out in the schedule to this Order.
