REGULATIONS

1. Title - These Regulations may be cited as the Manufacture of Intoxicating Liquor (Beer Duty) Amendment Regulations 1996 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Manufacture of Intoxicating Liquor (Beer Duty) Regulations 1987 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Rate of beer duty - The principal Regulations are amended by revoking Clause 4 and substituted the following new clause:

"4. Rate of beer duty - Beer duty shall be assessed and paid at the rate of 40 cents per litre."
