ORDER

1. Title - This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wage Order 1992 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
2. The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged 18 years and over - The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged 18 years and over shall be \$2.53 per hour.
3. The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged 16 years and over - The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged between 16 and 18 years shall be \$2.45 per hour.

4. The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged under 16 - The minimum wage prescribed for persons aged under 16 years shall be \$2.26 per hour.

5. Apprenticeship - Every person employed on a contract of Apprenticeship shall be paid in accordance with the relevant rates of pay set out in the Schedule to this Order.
