ORDER

1. Title and commencement - (1) This Order may be cited as the Outer Island Local Government (Remuneration of Councillors) Order 1988.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of February 1988.

2. Remuneration of Island Councillors - (1) The Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Councillors elected to an Island Council and every Ariki and representative of the Aronga Mana, who is a member of the Island Council, shall for the period 1st February 1988 to 31st July 1988, be entitled to receive the remuneration set out in the First Column of the Schedule hereto, for every month or part of a month in which that person holds office as a member of an Island Council.

(2) Every Mayor, Deputy Mayor Councillor elected to an Island Council and every Ariki and representative of the Aronga Mana who is a member of an Island Council, shall be entitled to receive as from the 1st August 1988 the remuneration set out in the Second Column of the Schedule hereto for every month or part of a month in which that person holds office as a member of an Island Council.
