POLICE AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1987

ORDER IN EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

At Avarua, Rarotonga, this 2nd day of October 1987.

PURSUANT to Section 49 of the Police Act 1981 His Excellency the Queen's Representative acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following Regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title - These regulations may be cited as the Police Amendment Regulations 1987, and shall be deemed part of and read together with the Police Regulations 1983 (hereinafter called "the principal Regulations").

2. Annual Leave - Section 39 of the principal Regulation is amended by adding thereto the following subsection:  
"(8) Except as otherwise provided by this section the Commissioner may with the consent of the Minister,  
(a) authorise any member to take pay in lieu of annual leave;  
(b) approve entitlement of miscellaneous, travel, accommodation, clothes, typewriter, mileage, and other allowances.

The Commissioner shall ensure that any authorisation given by him pursuant to subsection (1) shall, so far as is practicable, be consistent with the like authorisations and allowances from time to time prescribed in respect of members of the Public Service."

3. Allowances and expenses - Section 47 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting therefrom subsection (2).
