REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement - (1) These regulations may be cited as the Postal Amending Regulations 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1987.

2. Rates and charges - (1) The rates of postage for postal articles and the charges for postal services and all other services referred to in the Schedule to these regulations shall be the appropriate rates and charges specified in that Schedule.

(2) In the Schedule every reference to a weight shall include that weight or such weight not exceeding that weight.

3. Repeals - The Postal Amending Regulations 1984 are hereby repealed.
