- Title and commencement – (1) This Order may be cited as the Public Service (Board of Appeal Remuneration) Order 2001.  
(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 2001.

2. **Public Service (Board of Appeal Remuneration) Order 2001 2001/3A**

2. **Remuneration** – The member of the Board of Appeal who do not receive a salary from Government, shall be paid the following allowances -

- (a) the first two hours at a rate of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) per hour,
- (b) the third hour and onwards at a rate of sixty dollars (\$60.00) per hour,
- (c) the maximum sum payable on any one day is three hundred dollars (\$300.00) regardless of the total number of hours.
