ORDER

1. Title and commencement - (1) This Order may be cited as the Aged, Destitute and Infirm Persons Relief Order 1989.
(2) This Order shall come into force on 1 January 1989.
2. Rate of Payment - Pensions payable pursuant to Section 5 of the Aged, Destitute and Infirm Persons Relief Act 1966, shall be at the rate of \$100.00 per calendar month, commencing from and including the 1st day of January 1989.
3. Provision for relief - Relief payable pursuant to Section 15 of the Aged, Destitute and Infirm Persons Relief Act 1966, shall be at the rate of \$50.00 per calendar month, commencing from and including the 1st day of January 1989.
4. Revocation - The Aged, Destitute and Infirm Persons Relief Order 1988 is hereby revoked.
