REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement - (1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Amendment Regulations 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1959 (N.Z.S.R. 1959/93) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

(2) These regulations shall come into force on a day to be appointed by the Minister of Customs.

2. Overtime - (1) Regulation 13 (1) of the principal regulation is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the expression "\$7.67" and substituting with the expression "\$8.17".

(2) Regulation 13 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the expression "\$5.74" and substituting with the expression "\$6.11".

3. Fees for Officers' time - Regulation 14 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$3.83" and substituting with the expression "\$4.08".
