PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, and the Money Order Regulations 1949, His Excellency the Queen's Representative, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement - These regulations may be cited as the Money Order Regulations 1949, Amendment (No. 12) Order 1989 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Money Order Regulations 1949 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Commission and telegraph charges - The principal regulations are hereby amended by deleting subsection (1) of regulation 24 (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Money Order Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 11) and substituting the following subsection: -

"(1) The commission on a money order telegram payable within the Cook Islands shall be as set out in the First Schedule."

3. Schedule - The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting therein after clause 68 the First Schedule to these regulations.

4. Revocations - The regulations set out in the Second Schedule are hereby revoked.
