1. Salary and Allowances - (1) There shall be paid to the Clerk of the Parliament the following salary and allowances:

Salary	:		- \$27,588 per annum
Allowances	:	Penal	- \$ 1,250 per annum
		Representation	- \$ 750 per annum

(2) Where public servants receive a cost of living adjustment, that adjustment shall apply to the Clerk of Parliament's salary.
