PURSUANT to Sections 27 and 48 of the Cook Islands Shipping Ordinance 1963, the Cook Islands Marine Board hereby prescribes the following amendments to the Shipping (Maunga Roa) Rules 1996.

#### ANALYSIS

1. Title
2. Carriage of deck passengers when aviation gasoline or motor spirit or white spirit is carried.

---

1. **Title** – These rules may be cited as the Shipping (Maunga Roa) Rules Amendment 1997.

2. **Carriage of deck passengers when aviation gasoline or motor spirit or white spirit is carried** – Section 13 of the Rules is repealed by the following new paragraph.

- (i) No aviation gasoline or motor spirit or white spirit or a combination of all giving 40 drums or more or LPG cylinders are to be carried below deck
- (ii) When gasoline is carried on deck, no passengers are to be carried on the same deck.
