PURSUANT to Sections 27 and 48 of the Cook Islands Shipping Ordinance 1963, the Cook Islands Marine Board hereby prescribes the following amendments to the Shipping (Te Koumaru) Rules 1997.

ANALYSIS

1. Title
2. Dangerous Goods not be carried in enclosed spaces

1. **Title** – These rules may be cited as the Shipping (Te Koumaru) Rules Amendment 1997.

2. **Dangerous Goods not be carried in enclosed spaces** – Section 18 of the Rules is repealed by the following new paragraph.

- (i) No dangerous goods as defined in the Cook Islands Shipping Ordinance 1963, Section 12 and including LPG cylinders shall be carried in enclosed spaces.

These Rules are administered by the Cook Islands Marine Board.
