**SUMMARY OF RIGHTS
(AKAPAPAANGA TIKAANGA)**

1. This notice sets out one or more alleged minor offences. Each offence that is identified by a number is a separate minor offence.

**Payments
(Tutakianga)**

2. If you pay the minor offence fee within 7 days of the issue of this notice no further action will be taken. Payment is to be made at the Cook Islands Police National Headquarters, Avarua, Rarotonga.

**Defences
(Paruruanga)**

3. You have a complete defence against proceedings if the minor offence fee has been paid to the Cook Islands Police before or within 7 days after you have been served with the notice.

**Non Payment of Fee
(Tutakikore i te Utunga)**

4. If you do not pay the minor offence fee within 7 days of being served, you will be liable to prosecution in respect of the offence to which the notice relates and shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding \$100.00
