PURSUANT to section 2 of the United Nations Act 1946 of New Zealand, as applied in the Cook Islands by section 4 of that Act, His Excellency the Queen's Representative acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and for the purpose of giving effect to a resolution of the Security Council of the United Nations, adopted pursuant to the United Nations Charter on the 31st day of March 1992, calling upon the member States of the United Nations to apply in respect of South Africa the measures set out in that resolution, hereby makes the following regulations:
