**ORDER**

1. Title and commencement - (1) This Order may be cited as the Welfare (Destitute and Infirm Persons Relief) Order 2002.
- (2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2002.

2. Rate of Relief - Relief payable pursuant to Part IV of the Welfare Act 1989 shall be calculated as –

- (a) from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2002, at the rate of \$110 per month; and
- (b) from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2003, at the rate of \$120 per month, payable monthly.

3. Revocation - The Welfare (Destitute and Infirm Persons Relief) Order 1996 is hereby revoked.
